

## DIRECTIONS FOR PRINTING FORMS FOR THE NATIONAL TOURNAMENT

All of the required forms for the NCVF National Tournament will be pre-filled with information from the NCVF Registration system. It is important that **ALL** information on the NCVF Registration system is correct as well as complete prior to printing any forms. Failure to do so will result in you having to repeat the process.

Users that are managing a team must first select the team members that will be competing on each team before any forms can be printed. If you attempt to print the forms prior to selecting team members, blank forms will be created.

The data on each form is pre-filled from the NCVF Registration system. **HANDWRITTEN CORRECTIONS OR ADDITIONS** to forms will not be accepted for registration. All changes to data must be entered into the system and printed out. Failure to follow these directions will delay the registration process before and during the check in process.

Sign into the system using your user name and password.

From the Team Rep menu, click on the link to “Register for 2010 Nationals”.

The teams that you currently manage should also appear on your menu.

Below is a list of available teams from your school. Click the select button if you would like to register them for nationals.

The first section is the 'Current Tournament Roster' and lists all players that are currently registered on the team roster for the selected team.

If a player will not be attending the national tournament, click on the delete (X) button on the right side of the page to remove the player. This will not alter your current NCVF season roster for other purposes and tournaments. It will not delete the player from your team. It only eliminates them from being on the **NATIONAL TOURNAMENT ROSTER**.

The second section is the 'Available Players' and lists additional available players from the same institution that may be added to the selected team's national tournament roster. Players will only appear on one roster so it is important to select the correct players.

In order to move players from the 'Available Players List' to the 'Tournament Roster', you can select the checkbox for one or multiple players and click "Add Players to Roster" button. These players will be added to the Tournament Roster.

Once the roster is completed, click each of the required forms, complete and sign forms and ship to USA volleyball. Again, rosters must be completed prior to printing any forms. If there are changes to player information on the forms, information must be updated on the NCVF Registration system and then the appropriate form re-printed.

Team reps may check online for the status of the forms as part of the registration process.

<b>I. INTRODUCTION</b>					
1. The purpose of the NCVBF Code of Conduct is to describe expected behavior for all players, coaches, referees, staff, and spectators (collectively "participants") participating in NCVBF matches, sponsored or unsponsored events ("NCVBF Events").					
Players involved at a non-sports-related event are considered themselves and their team as a singular participant with their school's purpose as a post-secondary educational institution. Players are required to act in a mature and responsible manner when participating at an NCVBF Event. By participating in NCVBF Events, participants indicate they agree to the standards in the spirit of sportsmanship, have fun, and do not let the game win. Participants, however, will abide by the highest sportsmanship and ethical standards of conduct. Any request (e.g., from other teams, local government, media, local management) of activities that reflect negatively upon the NCVBF may result in sanctions or other appropriate actions in distressed areas. When participating in any NCVBF Event, players and teams must comply with all applicable policies, rules and regulations of their schools, leagues, conferences and the NCVBF.					
All teams shall designate Team Representatives who shall be responsible to communicate all NCVBF Code of Conduct related matters to their teams, players and applicable participants, and to all NCVBF recognized committees, player representatives, school officials and others.					
All participants will conduct themselves with honor and dignity. This includes playing volleyball for the game's sake, being gracious in a win or loss, respecting the speed of the game, and upholding the efforts of members and spectators.					
<b>II. THIS CODE</b>					
Participants will not:

2. Anyone may provide notice of a suspected violation of this Code by notifying the NCVBF Compliance Committee of the circumstances giving rise to the reported violation. The notice shall be sent to <a href="mailto:compliance@ncvbf.org">compliance@ncvbf.org</a> . The Committee shall reasonably expect to notify all applicable participants and other interested parties should it proceed with disciplinary action/disciplinary action, as provided herein.					
The NCVBF Compliance Committee will determine and impose any appropriate participant sanction or other action. The Committee will provide notice to the offending participant and team representative of the action or sanction, and efforts to deter appropriate. Participants shall give an opportunity to respond a period of the action or sanction so long as the report is made within two weeks and forwarded to the NCVBF Compliance Committee at <a href="mailto:compliance@ncvbf.org">compliance@ncvbf.org</a> .					
The NCVBF Compliance Committee shall have discretion to determine if sanctions or take other form of Committee compliance actions at the NCVBF National Collegiate Volleyball Championship Tournament that may not be subject to review. It is the discretion of the NCVBF Compliance Committee and Director of Competition, a series would cause delay or otherwise hinder effective administration of the championship tournament.
